

Wally Hase

Even before completing her studies with Prof. Jean-Claude Gérard and Prof. Aurèle Nicolet, the German flutist Wally Hase became principal flute of the Staatskapelle Weimar at the age of 22, a position she held until 2009.

In 2000 she was appointed full professor of flute at the Hochschule für Musik Franz Liszt Weimar. From 2014 to 2018 she also held a visiting professorship at the Akademia Muzyczna w Krakowie. Since October 2018, she has been Professor of flute at the Universität für Musik und darstellende Kunst Wien.

She continues her orchestral work as principal flutist with the Camerata Salzburg and with Cappella Andrea Barca under the direction of Sir András Schiff.

Alongside recitals, concerto appearances and extensive chamber music activities – including performances with Trio Lobkowitz Wien and in duo with guitarist Thomas Müller-Pering – she gives masterclasses throughout Europe, Australia, Asia and South America. Numerous radio and CD recordings as well as international jury engagements reflect the breadth of her artistic work.
